If you think the country look is a tad dated or doesn't quite blend well with apartment living, think again. Interior designer Jimmy Li of Carpenters helmed the creation of a contemporary farmhouse-inspired interior for this three-bedroom apartment in Newton Road. The result is a beautifully inviting and uncluttered home, which was renovated at a cost of \$220,000.

Wood accents are a given when it comes to achieving the rustic look, but Jimmy did not let them dominate. Instead, he generously incorporated raw-looking materials such as granite and irregular-sized stone tiles on the walls, creating a charming and elegant country ambience that will make you forget that this is a high-rise apartment.

Wooden beams on the ceiling further enhance the country theme. Colour palette-wise, grey and brown tones are the dominant hues for an overall earthy, yet clean and understated look. ▶

Even the kitchen (divided into dry and wet areas) was specially built to ooze a country home vibe. The cabinetry is clad in high-quality scratch-resistant veneer.

The rustic mod theme extends to the master bedroom and bathroom as well. Wooden panelling and greys feature prominently and lend a cottage-cosy atmosphere to the room.

The guest room, however, takes on a more conventional look, with white as the main theme. The design is deliberately kept clean and no-frills, yet the space is elegant and comfy at the same time. A grey head board, and brassy-gold bedside lamps and wardrobe knobs give a luxe feel to the space. ■
